

MISD AP Exam Fees 2018 – 2019

Basic Cost Assumptions (AP Exam Fees)

- The College Board fee for each AP exam in 2019 is \$94
- This price includes a \$9 administrative fee which MISD waives to lower the true cost per exam to \$85
- A district-sponsored subsidy in the amount of \$55 per exam will be applied in 2019
- **Students are responsible for the remaining balance of \$30 per exam**
- Free/reduced lunch students have all fees waived
- A \$15 unused test fee will be assessed for those missing their AP Exam without an excused reason
- Every student enrolled in an AP course will have the applicable exam ordered and fees stated above applied. AP Exam fees have already been uploaded in to the MISD HAC System
- Students ordering tests for courses not taken will pay \$85; this pricing would extend to home school students as well

In general, F/RL students pay \$0, non-F/RL students enrolled in course pay \$30, and non-F/RL students not enrolled in course pay \$85.

Since the courses are individually line itemed in HAC, parents have the option of partial payments if they need to spread out the reconciliation. Each transaction incurs a 2.4% convenience charge which means for one \$30 test fee the total transaction will run \$30.72. Parents with students obligated to multiple AP exam fees can pay for single exams on their own schedule if that works better and total transaction costs would remain the same since the convenience fee is based on the amount of the transaction.

We highly encourage parents and students to pay for their AP Exam fees online in the HAC System. You may need to **disable any pop-up blockers on your computer** when making your payment. Cash and check payments may also be made in the J207 office of Mr. Campos with his secretary Mary Bolsinger. We do not accept credit card payments in our J207 office. Thank you.

The deadline to pay for all AP Exam Fees is Friday, May 3rd, 2019.
