The next several weeks may present opportunities for inclement weather. During bad weather, MISD makes every attempt to assess the road conditions and notify staff and students as early as possible. Every effort is made to assess the road conditions and make a final decision by 5:30 a.m. Although, there have been cases where the weather worsened during the morning hours and a decision was made later than the 5:30 a.m. goal.

MISD will use several communication avenues to notify parents, students, and staff. The ParentLink automated phone calling system will be utilized in the event of a delay or school closure. If you recently changed phone numbers and have not notified your campus, please do so ASAP to ensure your information is accurate. Contact Caldwell's registrar at 469-742-5500. In addition, MISD will post the information on the McKinney ISD website at www.mckinneyisd.net, send an Email Extra notification, send a misdGO alert, and notify all local television and radio outlets.

Please keep in mind that MISD will not send out notifications to confirm school is in session. You will only be notified in the event of a delay or closure. Please do not rely solely on the phone call. The McKinney ISD website is the first place information is updated. ParentLink and MISD Email Extra are generally the second wave of communication received and television network updates are typically last (because there is often a lag time between when MISD sends the information to them and when it is posted).

If you have internet access, the McKinney ISD website will always be the quickest, most efficient, and most accurate way to find information on school closings.
