Dear Parent/Guardian:

March 9, 2009

Texas has revised the Immunization Laws. The new law went into effect on March 5, 2009. Your student will need proof of the following immunizations to pick up a 7th grade schedule for the 2009-2010 school year:

- Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis-containing vaccine (unless a booster dose received within the past five years)
- Meningococcal vaccine (one dose)
- Varicella vaccine (two doses received on or after 1st birthday)
- MMR vaccine (two doses received on or after 1st birthday)

The vaccines listed above are required *in addition to* those required by earlier laws. A signed statement of varicella disease will count towards the varicella requirement.

It is necessary for your child to be in compliance before the start of school. You must have proof of current immunizations to pick up your schedule for 2009-2010.
